Church Donates Computer... 51 students!

A Christian church has again assisted in reaching Spanish-speaking peoples with the gospel by donating a computer for **InHim** to use in managing the Spanish Bible correspondence course **Atravez de la Biblia** (Through the Bible).

Atravez de la Biblia is written by a Spanish speaking member of the restoration movement, and teaches from a New Testament perspective. Although students progress through the course at different paces, the average completion time of the first segment is about a year. The course has been instrumental to the ministry of **Mario Lara** in the newly established **Lifebridge Church of Christ**, in Des Moines, and in the wider project of **InHim** more recently.

The church has been using this course to build Bible knowledge and its accompanying spiritual development for several years. Lifebridge founder Mario reports, "It is a way to make new connections in areas distant from Des Moines, with new and established believers." An example is **Candelario Garcia.** After coming to the States from Mexico, he was invited to Lifebridge by a friend and mentored by Mario. He fell in love with Jesus and continues to study the Bible at church and using Atravez de la Biblia. Mario reports that Candelario was "thirsty to learn" and has been "one of the most faithful men" in the congregation, staying in the Word and assisting wherever he can. He is now the "student coordinator" of the course.
