After the 2018 tornado disaster in Marshalltown, IA., even though bad things happened, there is a silver lining. I participated as a volunteer as part of the HOPE4HEALING organization where we gathered information from the victims. Using this means, I had the opportunity to meet more families where I selected three families to help them find resources as explained below.

Marcela Torres is a single mother, a hard working woman, and her 11 year old son is named **Erick.** She



encountered problems with her home insurance to pay the damages which included the exhaust

duct on the heating system. Before the cold weather started, she did not have the means to repair the duct and the repair cost was too high in comparison to installing a new system. We were able to raise the funds to replace that furnace.

We are trying to visit these two communities one day each month with the purpose to establish family altars (small Bible study groups).

Lily Short, with Hispanic origins from Costa Rica, is a member of the Carrol Church of Christ. She has lived in Carroll for years and knows many Hispanic people in the area because of her previous job before retirement. It is easier and more effective to have a liaison to introduce the INHiM ministry to these communities.

The strategies we are using include: Visiting Hispanic businesses, direct dialog with people, and posting flyers of the INHiM ministry in the area. In some cases we gather contact information to start a data base of those people that have the potential to establish a family altar. The next step is to post an article in the local Hispanic newspaper for people to get to know about INHiM,
