2019 Hispanic Christian Convention...

In 1984, the **Hispanic National Christian Convention** was born in the city of San Antonio, TX. In the following years the convention was held in the states of Texas and California. Not until the year of 2001, the convention was taken to the city of Longmont, CO; and thereafter, to the city of Gering, NE. This change was due to the emerging of new Hispanic Christian churches in the United States. Iglesia de Cristo Puente de Vida church (Lifebridge) sponsored the convention and their work efforts was crucial since the church members participated in different work groups demonstrating that they can accomplish more as a church. During the event, the activities were divided in work groups, including 9 work groups locally and the national convention provided 5 work groups.

In 2019, the Hispanic National Christian Convention was held in **Pleasant Hill, IA.** There was an attendance of approximately **500 people**

from 13 different states in the USA and from Mexico.

For example, the kitchen work group cooked **2,200 dishes** during the time of the event (lunch and dinner); the coordinators were **Maricela Tristán**, **Roberto Macedo**, and **Rubén Her**- nández. This was the busiest area during the convention where a variety of meals were offered; the menu included beef BBQ, "tacos al pastor", pulled pork with its side dishes, and other delicious meals. The people were very happy with the free meals offered.

The workgroups in charge of serving the meals included voluntaries from English speaking churches across Iowa, the purpose was to foster an interaction between the Latino and American cultures. It was a good opportunity to exchange cultural knowledge and language skills.

Maria Lara and Clara Ibarra were the persons in charge of the Nursery work group and did an excellent job. The persons involved were volunteers from the American Christian churches where there was no language barriers; only the baby universal language which consist of crying, being fed, giggling or sleeping, depending on their needs.
