Lifebridge Church of Christ

Last year, the Latino National Christian Convention (CNC) of the Churches of Christ in the USA canceled the event due to COVID reasons, but this year we decided to hold it in Memphis, TN, from July 13 to 15, 2021. Midsouth Christian College was the host of this event. We had an attendance of around 250 people, normally the attendance is 600 people. Participants came from vari-

ous states including CA, OR, TN, TX, AL, IA, to name a few; of which 25% came from the state of lowa.

The total sale was around \$2,442.
